1. All yachts are allowed to tie up to floating jetty for 3 days for minor repairs on receipt of this form
2. After 3 days there will be a charge of R180.00 / day
3. Tying up the floating jetties will only be allowed once in a 3-month cycle unless it is an emergency or prior permission was granted by the Club manager.
4. The floating jetties shall not be used for repairs or refitting of boats, except for work of a minor or emergency nature and only with the completion of this form
5. Should any electrical power tools be used, the relevant permission from SanParks will have to accompany your application form.
6. KYC reserves the right to allocate a Jetty and control the nature of repair and hours of operation at their sole discretion.

INDEMNITY

I the undersigned, being the owner/skipper and duly authorised thereto by the owner of S/V do hereby indemnify the Knysna Yacht Club against any claim arising out of the use of the said yacht tied up to KYC jetties during the period stated.
