### BAR AND RESTAURANT PRICING STRUCTURE

Effective Friday 1st June, a new Menu and two tier pricing structure was introduced. To qualify for the "member price" which effectively awards a 10% discount on all menu items it will be necessary for the member to have deposited funds into their spending account facility and use their membership cards for payment as they would if using a debit card at the till.

For the past month all Bar pricing has had the benefit of an automatic 10% discount which will now fall away effective tomorrow Friday 1st June and to qualify for this ongoing privilege in respect of Bar pricing the same will apply as detailed above.
