OFFSHORE SAILING — Earle Seals

The Saturday morning sailing continues to be great success, attracting new members and maintaining the enthusiasm of of the majority of new sailors.

Breakfast at 09:00 is always a great way to get to know the group and hear the many sailing adventures of those having done the long voyages. More than few have been bitten by the sailing bug and gone on to buy their yachts and are now sailing and living their dreams around the world. We do however miss the amusing and short talks about the technicalities of sailing- we will try and do something about it. A vote of thanks, and it is much appreciated that we have so many skippers that offer to take crew and give them sailing experience and hopefully teach the art and rules of sailing.

The Buffalo Bay challenge, after a few years break, has been revived this season with three races on the calendar. The first sailed last year and, as often is the case, got nowhere near Buffels. The start was set off Knoetzi between Freya and a buoy with a turn mark set on the leading line and 20m depth contour. To my knowledge this was the first time buoys have been used and although it worked very well it was somewhat difficult to organize. Thanks to Roger and Terence for being on the bridge to record the finish. A good field of 7 keelboats and 2 dinghys took part. Another first was the use Willo as the rescue boat at sea and according to the crew Roland and Johan, who took a beating in the rough sea, this was the last. Dudley in his Finn and Robert in his Laser were brave enough to have a go but arrived at the start an hour early and decided it was too uncomfortable to wait. Their time was unfortunately not recorded but was certainly better than the winning keelboat.



The 2nd Buffalo Challenge was cancelled due to weather.

The 3rd Buffalo Challenge actually took place from Buffels although not without difficulty .Our President Jim Parks kindly obliged to be the start, but it was soon evident, the race had to be shortened because of light winds .However a field of 5 yachts started and finished with Roger again doing a great job on the bridge.
