PARKING ON CLUB PREMISES

In the interests of all and correct usage of our very limited parking area we wish to remind members:

Parking is permitted in clearly demarcated parking bays only

All vehicles utilising this area to please display 2017/2018 parking discs which is a clear indication of their having paid their subscriptions and an entitlement to park.

The parking area at the end of the walkway is available to handicapped members only displaying an official handicapped sticker. If however there is a need to park here due to a temporary disability following as an example an operation or accident please advise the Secretary accordingly and a temporary sticker will be issued.

There is no vehicle parking available in the areas demarcated for boat parking other than to collect/return boats and to load/off-load equipment

The public walkway adjacent to our parking bays is not available for parking

All areas demarcated with yellow painted lines is not available for parking e.g. in-front of workshops, sail and canoe storage and at the end of the driveway adjacent to the slipway.

In particular the area adjacent to the Loft also clearly marked must be kept clear at all times to afford the Municipality access to the drainage system

There is no facility available for the parking of trailers and after launching these must be parked in the trailer park in Long Street behind Tait Marine at the owner's risk.

Your full co-operation is anticipated to make your Club a more accessible friendly facility for all members to enjoy.
