GUIDELINES FOR VISITING YACHTSMEN TO KNYSNA YACHT CLUB

Welcome to Knysna Yacht Club.

Please introduce yourself to the Club Management and our Secretary upon arrival and should you wish to utilise the Club facilities please complete a visitors' application form and pay the applicable fees. A copy of this form is attached. Overseas visitors are granted free membership for a period not exceeding seven days

Detailed below are guidelines to assist you and make your stay with us a pleasurable experience

If you are mooring on the estuary it is important that you register with South Africa National Parks situated on Thesen Island – contact number 0443822095 and obtain a permit

Overseas visitors are required to obtain immigration clearance at the first port of entry to South Africa and if not done prior to visiting Knysna this may be done through South African Home affairs in George - 044 805 4117/076 598 4536

FLOATING JETTIES

1. No tenders shall be placed on top of floating jetties, except in exceptional circumstances with the permission of the Manager.
2. Tenders may not be left tied on the Western side of the deep-water floating jetties overnight. This space is reserved for emergency use by keelboats.
3. Tenders may be tied on the Western side of the two deep-water jetties during daytime, provided there is no other jetty space available, and provided that the owners remain on the KYC premises and are available to remove their tenders if requested by the Manager, any member of the General Committee or Keelboat skippers wishing to use the jetty.
4. No tenders, which are not in regular use, shall be left tied to the jetties.
5. All member's tenders tied to the jetties shall prominently display KYC registration numbers, and all tenders shall be registered with the Club Secretary and display current KYC parking stickers.
6. Members who use floating jetties regularly (see Clause 6.2) for tying up their tenders shall be required to pay for parking.
7. Yachts shall not remain tied to floating jetties overnight without KYC permission.
8. Yachts tied to floating jetties, which interfere with Club's organized sailing activities, will be required to move off if so instructed by the Race Officer on duty or a Committee Member.
9. No laundry shall be washed or dried on the floating jetties, nor shall laundry be hung out to dry on yachts tied to floating jetties.
10. The floating jetties shall not be used for repairs or refitting of boats, except for work of a minor or emergency nature, and then only with the permission of KYC

Please note: Knysna has strict water restrictions. Washing of yachts with a hose pipe is NOT allowed. The tap is only to be used to fill water containers.

Our Restaurant and Bar is open daily for Breakfast & Lunch except on Monday's.
Dinner is served on Wednesday's & Friday evenings.
