



Racing Signals

Knysna Yacht Club races under the ISAF Racing Rules. Full details of these can be found in the document "ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing" also on this website.

To simplify these we outline below the basic signals that the club uses.

Competitors should, of course, be familiar with the full range of signals

Procedure	Minutes before Start	Sound Signal	Visual Signal
Start:			
Class Identifier	5	One short blast 	Cone up 
	4	One short blast 	"P" Flag up 
	1	One long blast 	"P" Flag Down
	Start	One short blast 	Cone down.

General		Two short blasts 	"1st Sub" Pennant 

Individual		One short blast 	"X" Flag 
Course			
Shorten		Two short blasts 	"S" Flag 
Race Info			
Back to Back (Another race starting after finish of this race)			"L" Flag 
Race Abandoned		Three short blasts 	"N" Flag 
No More Races today		Three short blasts 	"N" over "A"
