FURTHER TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BYE LAW 6

1. All yachts are allowed to tie up to floating jetty for 3 days for minor repairs
2. KYC Members yachts allowed to tie up for 3 days
3. After 3 days there will be a charge of R250 / day
4. The floating jetties shall not be used for repairs or refitting of boats, except for work of minor or emergency nature and only with completion of this form.
5. Should any electrical power tools be used, the relevant permission from SanParks will have to be obtained.
6. KYC reserves the right to allocate a jetty and control the nature of repairs and hours of operation at their sole discretion.
7. No boat may be left unattended without prior arrangements. The club reserves the right to move any unattended yacht due to weather conditions or for any safety reasons. The club, members or staff will not be liable for any damaged that may occur during the move of yacht.

INDEMNITY

thereto by the owner of S/V do hereby indemnify the Knysna Yacht Club against any claim arising out of the use of the said yacht tied up to the KYC jetties during the period stated.
